Who Can Vote?

Resident Elector

You can vote in a local government election in the Township of Langley if you:

- are a Canadian citizen;
- are 18 years of age or older on general voting day (November 15);
- have lived in British Columbia for at least six months on the day of registration;
- have lived in the Township of Langley for at least 30 days prior to the day of registration; and
- are not disqualified by law from voting.

Township residents who meet these requirements can vote. It does not matter where you live in the Township or whether you rent or own your home.

Non-Resident Property Elector

If you own property in the Township of Langley but live somewhere else in British Columbia, you have a right to vote both where you live and where you own property.

You may vote as a non-resident property elector if you:

- are a non-resident elector in that community;
- are a Canadian citizen;
- are 18 years of age or older on general voting day;
- have lived in British Columbia for at least six months before you register to vote; and
- own real estate in the Township of Langley registered in your name for at least 30 days before you register to vote.

The Voting Process

There are two steps to voting in local government elections. First, ensure you are registered and, second, go to a voting place on election day.

1. Get Registered

You must be registered to vote. If you are unsure if you are registered, call our Election Headquarters.

The advance registration period closes on September 23, 2008. If you are not on the Township's Voters' List and missed the advance registration, you may still register in person on voting day. You must show two pieces of identification (at least one with a signature).

2. Go to a Voting Place on Election Day

Voting occurs between 8:00am and 8:00pm on November 15, 2008 at a voting place. (see the flip side for voting place locations)
